The LoJack transmitter can be randomly hidden in one of thirty places in the vehicle (stealth installation), preventing thieves from discovering and disarming it. LoJack tracking computers are installed in police cars, helicopters and fixed-wing aircraft, enabling police to recover vehicles quickly. In fact, if your vehicle is not recovered within 24 hours, the limited two-year warranty will cover the cost of your LoJack system up to the MSRP.

How LoJack works:

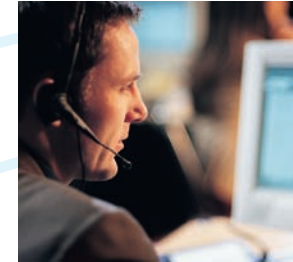
Installation

The LoJack unit is hidden in the vehicle by a certified technician. The unit is registered in the LoJack database.



Notification

The customer reports the theft to police, to activate the unit and then contacts LoJack for additional assistance.



Activation

When the vehicle is reported stolen to the police, a radio signal is sent from towers to the LoJack unit in the stolen vehicle. The unit emits a uniquely coded signal to the police.



Tracking

Police track the signal and use it to recover the vehicle, many times within hours.



Recovery

The vehicle is returned to the owner.



LoJack tracking systems may provide discounts on your comprehensive auto insurance up to 33%. Compare that to factory security systems, which may provide a discount of 5–7%.

Other security systems are GPS-dependent, requiring a clear view to the sky. LoJack works by radio frequency which can track vehicles in underground garages, or inside shipping containers.

Equipped with a back-up battery, LoJack works even if the vehicle's power is disabled. GPS products won't work without power.

Factory security systems deter theft using only audible sirens and an immobilizer. LoJack allows police to track and recover stolen vehicles.

Factory security systems require the driver to activate them upon leaving the vehicle. LoJack is registered in a database that can be activated by the police.

During the first two years of ownership, LoJack will refund the purchase price of the system if your vehicle is stolen and not recovered within 24 hours.
